Undergraduate/Graduate Concurrent Enrollment Approval Form

Under certain special circumstances, an undergraduate student with good academic standing may be allowed to enroll in up to 9 hours of graduate courses. Before concurrent enrollment is permitted, the student must meet the following requirements:

1. Be within 30 credit hours of completion of a Baccalaureate degree.
2. Carry a minimum of a 3.0 undergraduate GPA
3. Graduate credit earned during concurrent enrollment may not be used to fulfill any undergraduate requirements.
4. Total registration may not exceed 15 credit hours in one semester.
5. Approval by the graduate program advisor, the undergraduate college dean, and the dean of the Graduate School.

**If concurrent enrollment is sought for summer semester, undergraduate and graduate enrollment may not exceed 3 credit hours a piece for a combined total of 6 credit hours.

I have read the above requirements and understand that failure to meet the conditions specified will make me ineligible for graduate enrollment.
