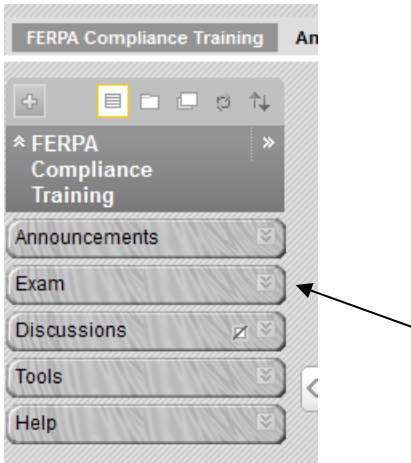

FERPA Exam

This is a twenty choice multiple choice and True/False test.

A passing score is 90 percent, or 18/20. You may retake the exam until you pass.

To find out the results of the test:

1. Take the exam.
2. Click on Save and Submit at the end of the exam.
3. Click OK in the lower right corner of the Test Submitted screen.
4. You will see your score followed by detailed feedback for each answer.
